On our website, you'll also find the 2012-2013 NAEP (National Assessment of Educational Progress) results in Reading and Math from many students across the state in fourth and eighth grades. These results give us a picture of how Maine students compare to other states across the nation.

The scores reported out for the 2016-2017 NCLB Report Card originate from the state testing students completed during the 2016-2017 school year. A new accountability system will come from the state following the 2016-2017 state testing since there were testing program changes. As you know, the state switched the way students were tested by moving from the NCLB Assessment to the Smarter Balanced Assessment the following year, and now to the MEA Assessment.
