SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The Board conducts various types of meetings as described in this policy. All meetings of the Board are open to the public except for executive sessions.

Regular Meeting: A business meeting of the Board shall be held monthly.

Workshop Meeting: A meeting called to discuss particular subjects or proposals, or

to gather input from staff, students and/or the community.

Special Meeting: A business meeting called between scheduled regular meetings

to address important matters that arise between regular meetings and require Board action, or to consider a particular subject. A special meeting may be called by the Board Chair, at the request of the Superintendent, or upon written request by

four Board members.

Executive Sessions: An executive session shall be called and conducted in

accordance with state law. Only the matter(s) stated in the motion to enter executive session shall be considered. No final

action may be taken in executive session.

Adjourned Meeting: When the Board is unable to complete the work it has

scheduled at a regular or special meeting, it may, by majority vote, adjourn until a specified time set for an "adjourned meeting." Public notification shall be given of the time and

place of the adjourned meeting.
